

Forever Gingerbread Party Checklist

Before the Party

- ☆ Popsicle sticks
- Store bought white icing or homemade icing
- ☆ Small plastic cups (ie. salsa cups at Moe's)
- ☆ Heavy paper or plastic plates (ie. red solo or white chinet)
- Disposable wipes for each table
- Scissors for easy candy opening

Day of the Party

- ☆ 1 house for each child's place
- ☆ 1 plate of candy
- ☆ 1 small plastic cup of icing/popsicle stick
- Piping bag/plastic baggie with end snipped
- ☆ Older guest (?)

What to send home

- ☆ Wrap plate/gingerbread house in large cello bag
- ☆ Tie with ribbon for easy transporting
- ☆ Include Forever Gingerbread recipe card in the bag (works well under the plate)
- ☆ Label child's name on a small Forever Gingerbread log tag
- ☆ Tie ribbon and send home for guests to enjoy

How to Clean Your House

- ☆ Rinse your house with warm water and candy will fall off
- ☆ Do not use sponge or wash cloth
- ☆ Use light layer of soap and rinse again if there's leftover icing residue

Helpful Hints

- ☆ Have extra icing cups/popsicle sticks for those who run out quickly and want to keep going
- ☆ Use halloween candy
- ☆ Cereal works great on the houses and is cheap! You can even find Christmas cereal
- ☆ Favorites we use are: Fruit loops, mini marshmallows, M&Ms, gummies and graham crackers
